Frequently Asked Questions

1. What ages do you accept for AfterSchool:

Pine Ridge Elementary – PreK students – 5th grade
Ferdinand/Tri-County YMCA – PreK students – 5th grade
Holy Trinity Central Campus – PreK (4 yr olds) – 5th grade
Jasper Elementary – KG – 5th grade

2. How are the students divided into groups during AfterSchool?

We are working closely with the schools to have designated space and will have students designated to specific groups. We will be rotating between the common areas.

3. How many students will you be accepting for the AfterSchool Program?

Pine Ridge – 12 students
Ferdinand/Tri-County YMCA - 24 students
Holy Trinity Central Campus – 48 students
Jasper Elementary – 48 students

4. How does the Payment Contract work?

Our 2020 AfterSchool Program is a part-time and full-time program. Parents can enroll their student based on a 3 day attendance or 5 day attendance schedule.

If your student will be attending AfterSchool 1 – 3 days a week, you will enroll your student in the 3 Day Contract and will be responsible for paying the weekly fee for that contract no matter how many days your child attends AfterSchool.

If your child will be attending AfterSchool 4 – 5 days a week, you will enroll your student in the 5 Day Contract and will be responsible for paying the weekly fee for that contract no matter how many days your child attends AfterSchool.

5. Do I have to indicate which 3 days my child will attend AfterSchool?

No, you do not have to let us know which 3 days (or less) your child will be at AfterSchool.

6. What happens if I am enrolled in the 3 Day Contract and I need my student to come an extra day one week?

You will need to email the AfterSchool Coordinator and let her know about the need of care for the extra day and you will be charged the difference of fees for the extra day.

7. What is the registration fee for the program?

For one child the registration fee is \$30.00
For a family the registration fee is \$50.00.

8. What happens if the school shuts down, will I have to pay for the week?

If the school shuts down due to COVID, you will not be charged for those days.

9. What happens if I enroll my student for the AfterSchool Program and I no longer need care after a couple of week? Am I committed to paying for the entire semester?

When registering your student, you are registering the student for the fall semester and will be responsible for paying the weekly fees each week. If your plans change and you need to remove your child from the program, you will need to contact Jami Ferguson, AfterSchool Coordinator, to inform her about the situation and request a cancellation form.

10. How will I make payments?

When registering your student through the online link, you will be asked to submit a CC, checking, or savings account and will remain on file. The form of payment will be charged on Saturdays and will be for the week of AfterSchool that was just finished.

11. What are the pick up procedure?

Pick up procedures will vary by AfterSchool location.

Pine Ridge: Parents will drive around to the back of the school building and enter door #7. (Art Room Door) Parents must enter wearing a mask and are not permitted to pass the table.

Tri-County YMCA: Parents will enter the YMCA and must enter wearing a mask. Parents will inform the courtesy desk of the child they are picking up and a staff will bring your child up front.

Holy Trinity Central Campus: Parents will pull in the parking lot located across from the playground and wait by the flag pole doors. A phone number will be provided prior to the start of AfterSchool. Parents will call the number, indicate the child's name, and a staff will bring you your child.

Jasper Elementary: Parents will drive around to the back of the school building and walk up to door #26 (gym doors) A phone number will be provided prior to the start of AfterSchool. Parents will call the number, indicate the child's name, and a staff will bring you your child.

12. Does my child have to wear a mask?

Yes, your child will have to wear a mask during the AfterSchool Program. There will be times when a mask is not required.

13. What is the AfterSchool structure?

In general, the AfterSchool time consists of snack (items will be prepackaged), character development, fitness fun, reading time, homework time, gym/outside play, and activities. The groups will have a rotated schedule.

14. Will my student receive tutoring during homework time?

No, students will not receive tutoring services during AfterSchool time. Students will be asked to get their homework out, (staff is not permitted to go in the child's backpack), and time is allotted for students to work on homework. Students will have the opportunity to ask questions and staff will do their best to help, but the YMCA can not guarantee homework will be completed. We encourage parents to check their child's homework at home.
